PROJECT DURATION: March 2005. - March 2006.

OBJECTIVE: The promotion, protection and improvement of the human rights of women who were victims of torture during the war in BH 1992. -1995.
DONOR: European Union
BUDGET: 74.860,00 €

The objective of the project is, with the changes and amendments to the Law on basic social protection, protection of civilian victims of war and protection of families with children of FBH, to allow women - victims of war health and social rights that they did not possess until now. The project is realized in cooperation with UG "Women-victims of war". Within the framework of the project 10 round tables were held (in cooperation with the Gender Centre of the Federation of BH) for the sensibilization of the public to this problem and for acquainting them with the proposals for the changes and amendments to the Law.

PROJECT: "The prevention of violence among adolescents"

OBJECTIVE: To acquaint adolescents of certain elementary schools, 4 (four) from the area of the Centre municipality, with target education to acquire basic knowledge of types of violence, its recognition, and protection from violence

Devised trainings and lectures for adolescents concerning the problem of violence (the concept of violence, types of violence, how to recognize it and how to react to the presence of violence); with the distribution of questionnaires created exclusively for this population and for the aforementioned purpose of the project, and the distribution of promotional material designed and devised to send the message to young people in a popular and simple (acceptable) manner how to react in the fight against violence in society, especially domestic violence, the purpose of the project is realized; to prevent violence through information about the problem of violence.

The project trained 10 people during three-month training for work on the Green Line. A total of 12 radio shows were aired for the purpose of informing the public about basic human rights and the promotion of the Green Line. Based on the analysis of the telephone calls and media campaign realized within the framework of this project, securing relevant data and input that may help in the definition of necessary statistical monitoring of a certain population (young people and women in Bosnia-Herzegovina) in the domain of their sexual and reproductive rights, and the right to a life without gender-based violence.

The general aim of the project is to promote a healthy lifestyle among the young people of Sarajevo with the distribution of promotional material. The promotional material will, in an adequate manner, offer information about violence, sexual and reproductive rights (problems of unwanted pregnancies, sexually transmitted diseases), possible ways of becoming victims of violence or trafficking, and in that way decrease the risk of possible problems related to these issues within this population.

Seventeen children without parental supervision (members of the Citizen's Association "Education builds Bosnia-Herzegovina") with 2 (two) additional guides visited Barcelona. The children from Sarajevo were participants of the "Peace Camp". "Peace Camp" collected children from 8 (eight) different cities around the world. (Sarajevo, Tetuan, Montevideo, Monerry, Maputo, Gwangju, Gudix, Barcelona) with the aim of mutual acquaintance and presentation of cultural and natural heritage of each country through several different activities. The activities were directed towards children's rights, protection of peace, conflict resolution in a non-violent manner, the concept of democracy.

The purpose of the project is to educate beneficiaries that are currently located in the Shelters for victims of violence, about culinary techniques. The training will be conducted, as a work-occupational therapy, for all women/girls that are located in the Shelter, that were victims of violence or trafficking.

The training will ensure basic culinary knowledge for the beneficiaries that they may use later, not only in self-employment, but also in the sense of the realization of right to a work contract, as well as saving the home budget. The project includes the purchase and installing of new equipment in the kitchen of the Shelter.

The project is realized in two phases. The first phase is the establishment of virtual contact of the pupils through the internet for the purpose of getting to know each other better. The second phase allow a group of pupils from the elementary school "Hrasno" a visit to Barcelona for the purpose of meeting their peers and strengthening future bonds.
